INVESTIGATOR**

The Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Oklahoma is accepting applications for the position of Investigator. More than one position may be filled by this announcement. The federal defender organization operates under the authority of the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, to provide defense services in federal criminal cases and related matters in federal courts.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Investigator reviews and analyzes discovery and other case documentation, initiates new areas of investigation, locates and conducts objective interviews of witnesses, evaluates witnesses, works with experts, locates and retrieves evidence, gathers and maintains records, assist attorneys at hearings and trials, serves subpoenas and coordinates witnesses, and performs all other duties as assigned. Travel required.

REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS:

The successful candidate must have a comprehensive knowledge of investigative principles and techniques, a basic understanding of criminal law, procedure, and evidence, and a minimum of six years of experience as an investigator.

SALARY & BENEFITS:

This is a full-time position. Federal salary and benefits apply. Salary is commensurate with experience and education. This position is subject to mandatory electronic transfer (direct deposit) of net pay. The selected candidate will be subject to a background check as a condition of employment.
