The Non-Capital Habeas Unit represents state prisoners in federal habeas corpus proceedings. The Legal Assistant is critical to the day-to-day functioning of the unit and contributes to the excellent representation of incarcerated individuals throughout the state, upon which the Unit prides itself.

Applicants must have strong oral and written communication skills and strong interpersonal skills. Applicants must be able to handle confidential matters with discretion, exercise mature judgment, work well both independently and on teams, and work on multiple projects with deadlines simultaneously. Applicants must also possess well-developed organizational skills, interpret and apply procedural rules of the court, and work well under pressure in a high-volume, fast-paced environment.
