ORDER APPOINTING FEDERAL PUBLIC DEFENDER

Pursuant to the provisions of the Criminal Justice Act [18 U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(1),(c)], the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida is hereby appointed for limited purposes to represent **Deshawn Travis Glover** in this case. The Federal Public Defender shall determine whether the defendant may qualify to seek a reduction of sentence in accordance with the revised base offense levels for crack cocaine authorized by Guideline Amendment 706 [November 1, 2007] and Policy Statement 1B1.10 (effective March 3, 2008). If appropriate, the Federal Public Defender may file or otherwise present motions on behalf of the defendant for a reduction in sentence. This appointment is limited to cases affected or potentially affected by this retroactive amendment. The appointment herein shall not apply if the defendant has retained counsel; if the defendant does not financially qualify under 18 U.S.C. § 3006A; or if it presents a conflict for the Federal Public Defender (in which case, the Federal Public Defender shall promptly notify the Court).

The United States Probation Office for the Northern District of Florida is authorized to disclose Presentence Investigation Reports and Statements of Reasons to the Federal Public Defender's Office for any such defendant. The United States Probation Office shall also provide copies of the Presentence Investigation Reports and Statements of Reasons in this case to the Office of the U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Florida.

In accordance with the policy of the Federal Bureau of Prisons, no Presentence Investigation Reports will be provided to Inmates. Any Recalculation Worksheets created by the U.S. Probation Office will be treated as Supplements to the Presentence Investigation Reports for purposes of these disclosure provisions.
