ORDER

This case is before the Court on defendant's *pro se* Motion for Appointment of Counsel [115] filed March 20, 2008. It appears that defendant is filing this motion in anticipation of filing a Motion for Reduction of Sentence, pursuant to 18 § 3582.

The Court imposed a 292-month term of imprisonment on July 18, 2002. The probation office advises that defendant does not appear to be qualified for a reduction of sentence pursuant to the retroactive crack guidelines, due to the fact that he was sentenced as a career offender and that the quantity of crack he possessed exceeded 4.5 kilograms. Nevertheless, the Court will appoint defendant a public defender to consult with and represent him on this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendant's *pro se* Motion for Appointment of Counsel [115] is **GRANTED**. The Court appoints the **Federal Defender Program** to consult with and represent the defendant

on the filing of his Motion for Reduction of Sentence, pursuant to 18  
§ 3582.
